## A Guiding Course for Grade - 7 Students to Create Stories

## Abstract

There are many students who are weak in creative writing. The undertaking of this research mainly aimed to develop creative story writing skill of the seventh grade students from Government Schools. This research emphasized on constructivism which gives the autonomy to the students. In the research, the advantages of using constructivism for creative writing were discussed. This research also showed the students' writing improvement by comparing pre-test and post-test results. After analyzing the students' answer in pre-test, it was found that the score of students' writing skill was very low.
