

# Study on Outstanding Characters of Five *Citrus* Species

## Abstract

In this paper, the study on outstanding characters and nutritional values of five selected species of citrus fruits were presented. These plants were collected from Hlegu Township, Yangon Region, during December 2021 to May 2022. These selected plants were *Citrus aurantifolia* (Christm) Sw. (Thanbaya); *Citrus limon* (L.) Burm.f. (Than-bayo); *Citrus medica* L. (Shauk); *Citrus maxima* (Burm.) Merr. (Kywe-gaw) and *Citrus sinensis* L. (Lein-maw) belong to the family Rutaceae. These selected plants are small trees or shrubs and aromatic. The nutritional values of the five selected fruits showed that proteins, fats, fibers, carbohydrates and vitamin C were presented as a different amount in each species. In this paper, the list of five selected species of citrus and their photographs were also presented.
